# The Sacred Choice: To Heal and To Love Yourself

#### Steps:

- 1. Light your candle with the intention: "Today I choose healing. Today I choose love."
- 2. Place your hand on your heart and breathe slowly until you feel centred.
- 3. Speak aloud:
- "I choose to heal myself, so I may live in freedom."
- "I choose to love myself, so I may live in truth."
- 4. Write down one wound you are ready to release and one way you can love yourself today.
- 5. Hold the paper to your heart and say: "Heal my heart, heal the world." Then keep it in your journal or safely release it to the flame.
